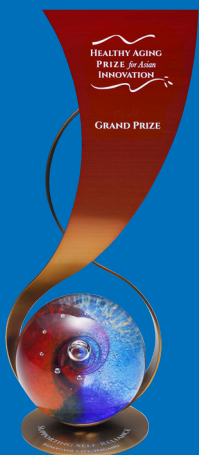

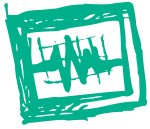

## Award Categories



### Technology & Innovation

New technologies and techniques that encourage healthy and productive aging, that improve the way that older persons receive care, or that provide greater efficiency, safety, and/or convenience for older persons and caregivers



### Community-Based Initiatives

Community-based approaches—including inter-generational approaches—to keeping older adults healthy, active, engaged, and/or safe



### Supporting Self-Reliance

New ways to help older adults maintain, improve, or restore their ability to carry out activities of daily living (ADL) and to age in place

## Eligibility

Eligible innovations include policies, programs, services, and products implemented by community organizations, nonprofit organizations, research institutions, local governments, private businesses, public-private partnerships, and social businesses based in an ASEAN member country or in China, Japan, or South Korea.
